Scarboro remains the only course outside the U.S. designed by Albert Warren Tillinghast, one of North America’s premier designers. Tillinghast masterfully used Highland Creek and the hilly terrain, gullies and trees as natural hazards, making artificial hazards almost unnecessary.

This year, Golf Classic guests will be joined by three golf personalities — all avid golfers and sure to entertain throughout the day!

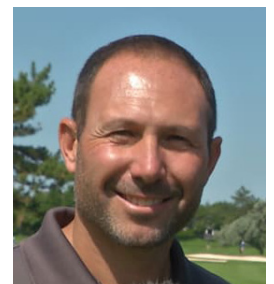
