# Can a fun night on the town make an impact on healthcare?

Yes it can! Each year, proceeds from East End Eats support a hospital project that would otherwise go unfunded. The Impact Council selects the project after hearing pitches by Michael Garron Hospital healthcare teams on ideas relating to patient care, research and equipment.

Last year these funds were awarded to the Stavro Emergency Department. Thanks to everyone who supported East End Eats, people who need emergency treatment in East Toronto now have more streamlined care, making a stressful time easier for themselves and their loved ones.

With the \$70,000 raised, our Emergency Department has been able to:

- Implement a new virtual waiting room program
- Introduce a physician-led quality improvement at triage
- Pilot an innovative wait time clock, one of the first in Toronto

The government doesn't fund upgrades like these. But your philanthropy does.
